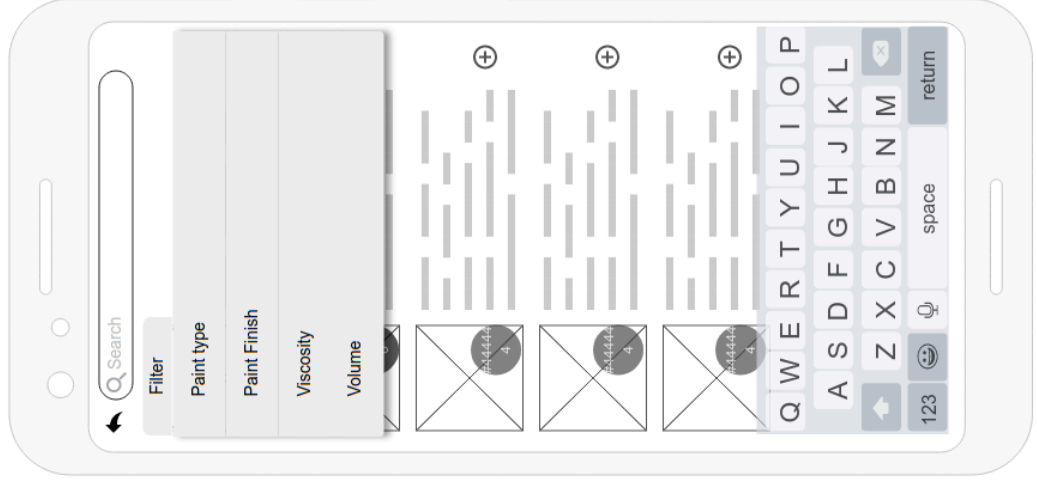
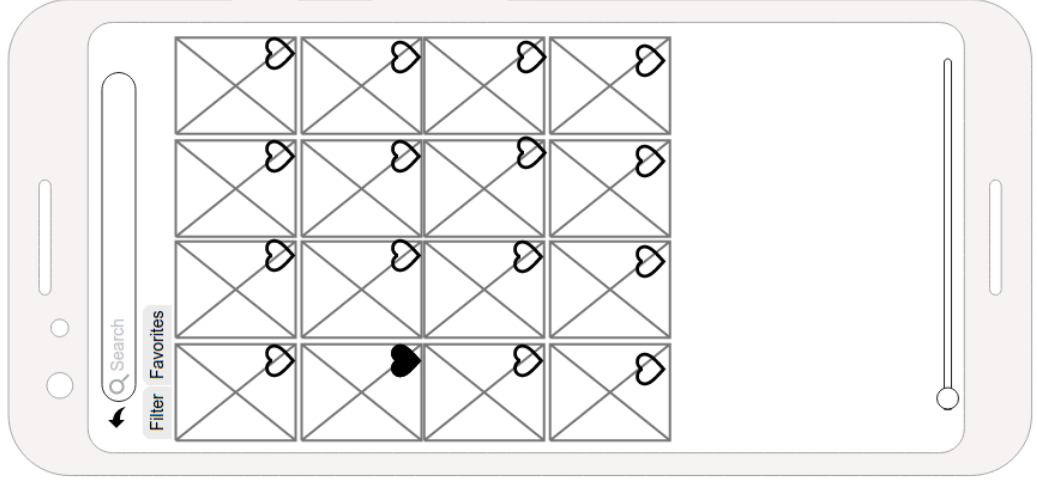
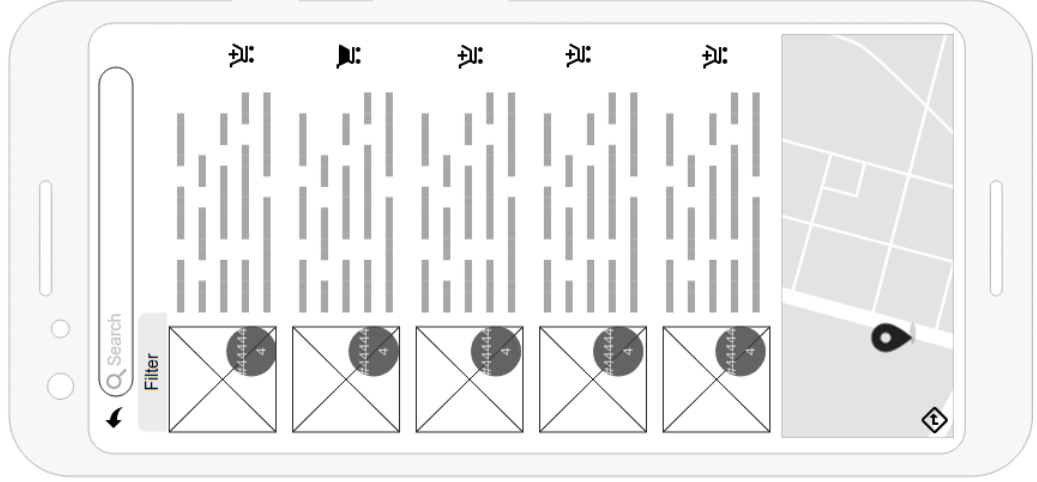
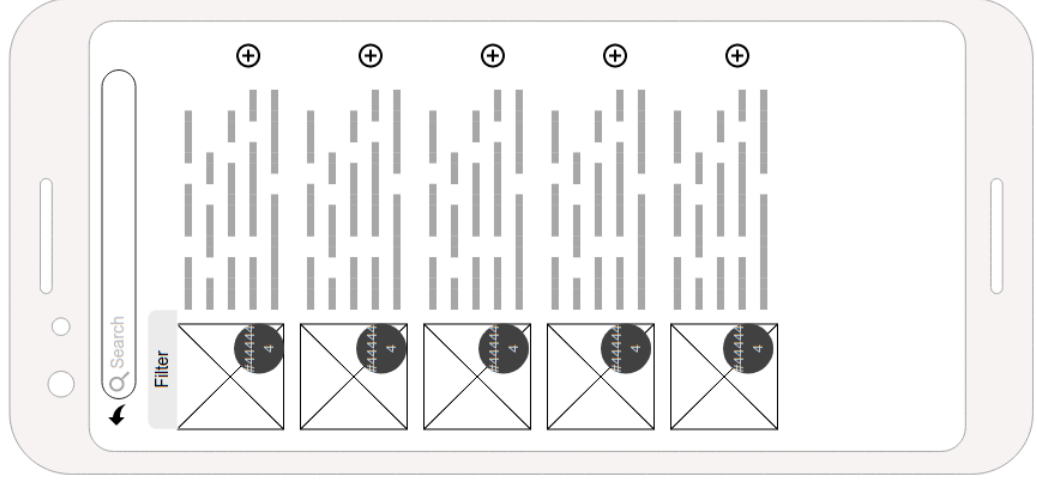


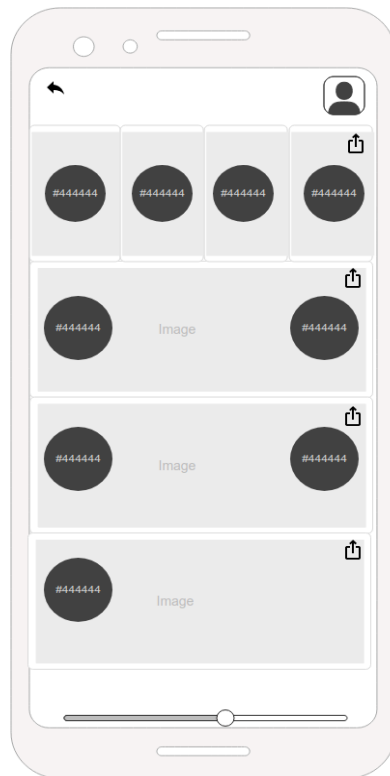
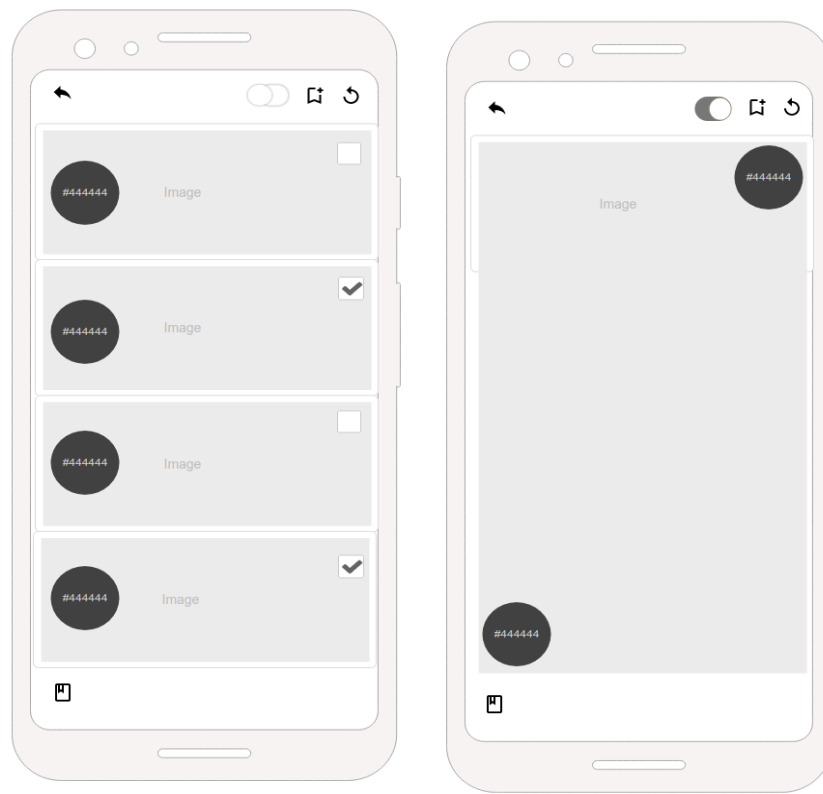
New Colour Match Pathway
